Unfortunately, the food bank are unable to accept perishable items, however below is a list of items which The Wantage and Grove Foodbank currently require:

- Tinned soup, vegetables
- Tinned fish, meat
- Tinned or dried potato
- Rice
- Pasta
- Pasta sauce
- Tinned fruit
- Tins/packets of pudding
- Jam
- Biscuits
- Cereal
- Tea, coffee
- hot chocolate (mix with water)
- Small bags of sugar

We ask that donations from Endeavour pupils be placed on the stage in the hall. For Inspire pupils, donations must be taken to class and we will pop donations in the hall at the end of each day.
